Reading Assignments

Complete three book reports. These are due on the first day of school.

1. Choose two books of your choice to read. Both books must be at least 150 pages. Please complete a book report on both books. The third book report is on Dewey the Library Cat.
2. The book reports can be handwritten on notebook paper if you have neat handwriting or typed - your choice. If your handwriting is not neat please type them. If you do not have a printer I can print them on the first day of school.
3. All three book reports must include the following information for full credit
 - Who are the characters in the story & who is the main character
 - Who is your favorite character & why are they your favorite
 - One paragraph about the beginning of the story
 - One paragraph about the middle of the story
 - One paragraph about the ending of the story
 - All three paragraphs should be 4 -6 good sentences.
 - Please double check spelling, grammar & punctuation

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4. Please read the book Dewey the Library Cat.

Please take care of the book Dewey the Library Cat. Complete a book report using the requirements listed above. You will need to return the book on the first day of school.

5. Math Assignments
